note that the adoption of the TPNW by 122 countries, with it now having being signed by 80 states and ratified by 35, is evidence of the desire to achieve the objective of a nuclear weapons-free world: stress that nuclear disarmament cannot be separated from collective security and can only be achieved by taking the strategic context into account, and that it must be part of a gradual process guaranteeing the undiminished security of all while preventing any new arms race; recall that, as a means of preventing the quantitative development of nuclear weapons arsenals, the Fissile Material Cutoff Treaty is a vital and irreplaceable step towards a world free of nuclear weapons;
