(a) reiterate that effective ***multilateralism*** and ***a rules-based international order*** are a precondition for countering the proliferation of nuclear weapons; reaffirm that the NPT is a cornerstone of the nuclear non-proliferation and disarmament regime, a vital bulwark against the risk of nuclear proliferation, and an irreplaceable framework for maintaining and strengthening peace and security worldwide;

(a) reiterate that effective ***bilateral*** and ***multilateral agreements*** are a precondition for countering the proliferation of nuclear weapons; reaffirm that the NPT is a cornerstone of the nuclear non-proliferation and disarmament regime, a vital bulwark against the risk of nuclear proliferation, and an irreplaceable framework for maintaining and strengthening peace and security worldwide;

(c) *emphasises that an EU common position as regards the NPT Review Conference is not possible, as the EU consists of one nuclear weapon state, non-nuclear weapon states and states that have nuclear weapons on their territory, and therefore notes that neither the EU nor the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy can adequately defend and protect the national interests of the Member States at the NPT Review Conference;*

Amendment

(k)a Points out, however, that only one Member State of the European Union possesses a sovereign nuclear weapon; stresses that it is the sole responsibility of that Member State to finance it, develop it and determine its use in accordance with its international commitments; opposes any proposal to mutualise this tool;
